

ARCHDEACONRY OF FRANCE AND MONACO FEEDBACK FORM RESULTS FROM SYNOD 2021

1 Survey information and database

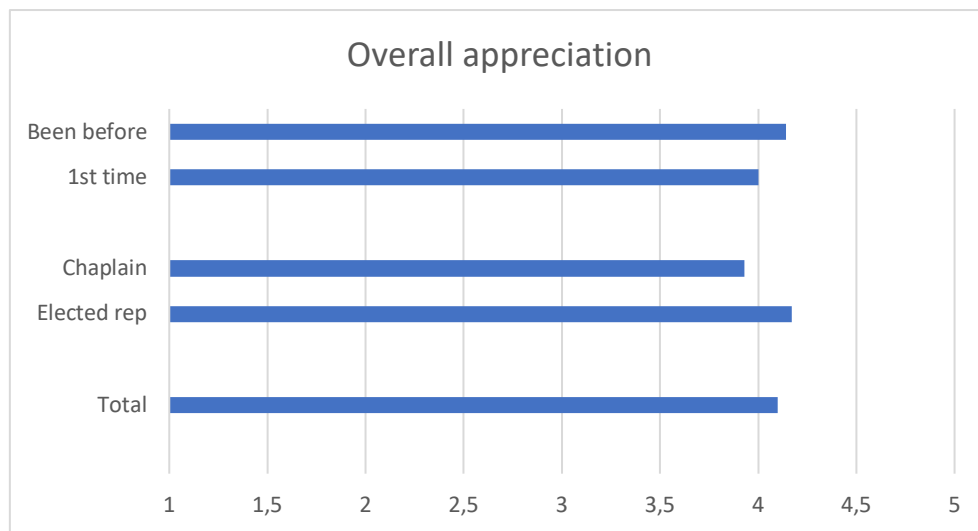
This feedback survey used a web-based form on our Archdeaconry France website.

A total of 47 respondents answered the survey out of a possible 75 of those present (47 Elected representatives, 21 chaplains and 7 PTO).

As the total numbers are less than 100, none of these results are statistically significant; they do however show some trends.

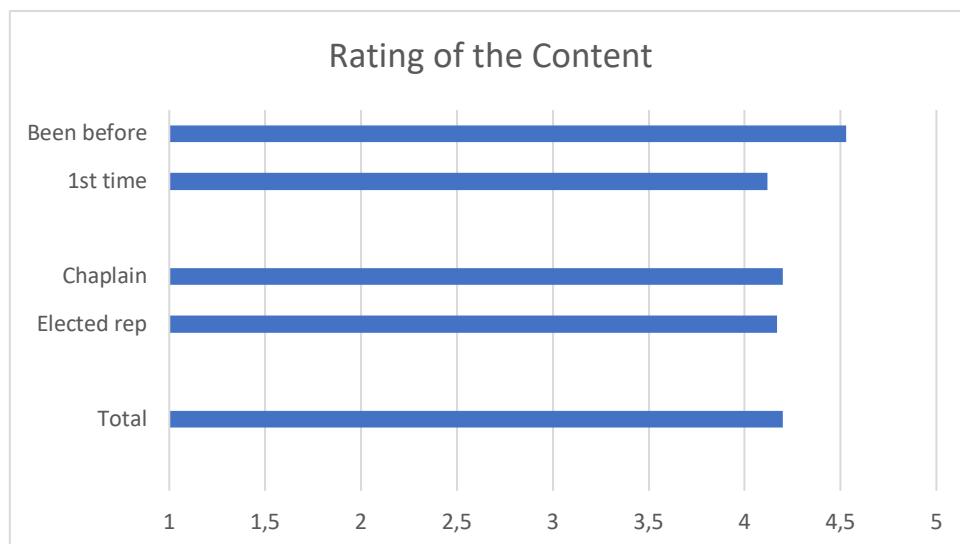
2 Overall experience

The average rating was very positive at over 4/5. There was no real difference between those who had attended an in-person synod in the past and new members, nor between chaplains and elected representatives.



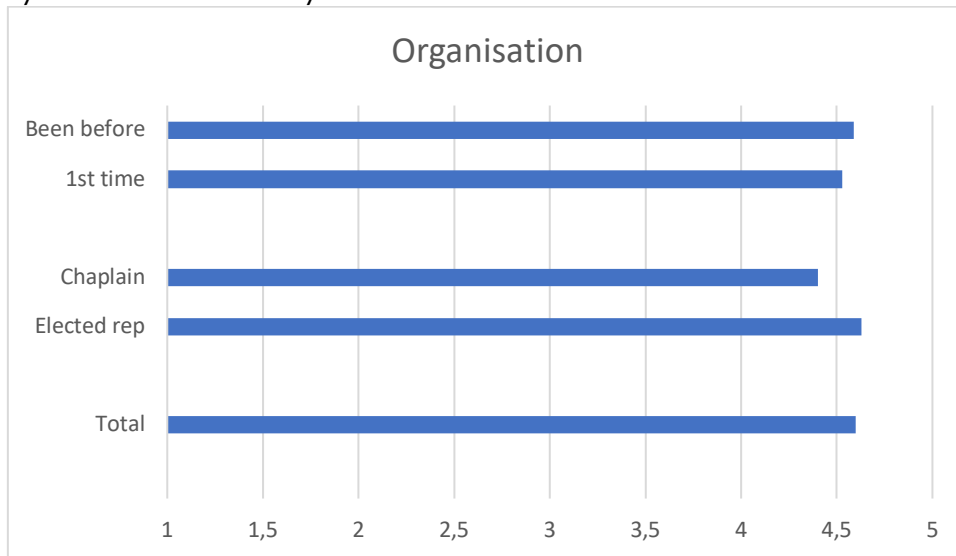
3 Content
