2 Apart from this particular Christmas edition, chaplaincies can **upload information about their church, their forthcoming events or news**, to the Connexion France website (link as above) and this will appear on their “**Community**” page. This is possible all through the year, not just at Christmas.

It is a good way of getting known, and chaplaincies in Aquitaine and Brittany are already posting news on this site – it’s perhaps time we **all** took advantage of this free service.

- Register on the site (it’s free)
- Go to the Community page
- Upload a text (no images) notice about your chaplaincy

3 If you have a **forthcoming event**, you can upload this in the same way. An important event needs to be uploaded well in advance; the newspaper may want to write a longer article about it.
