

Programme Proposals 2 (i)

Programme to include break-out groups as well as time altogether

Based on a central theme from across the Diocese and as used at Diocese Synod



Programme Proposals 2 (ii)

All Archdeaconry Synod (Deanery) meetings in the Diocese taking place in an autumn 'synod season'

Specific items from Diocesan Synod can easily be cascaded down

Wider participation allows for more successful information sharing, not just the domain of the Synod Reps.
