# **Our Immediate Mission:**

To reach as many vulnerable and isolated UK nationals in France who may still be unaware of the need to apply for residency **before the deadline of 30 June 2021**.

# What is the UKNSF?

Taking Action? The **UK Nationals Support Fund** is a UK Government funded programme to assist UK Nationals (UKNs) with residency in the EU following Brexit.

UK nationals must apply for residency in their respective EU country to retain their rights under the Withdrawal Agreeement.

In France?

Four Implementing Partners were awarded funds in France to provide regional assistance to UKN who may need help making their residency application. Under French legislation UKNs legally residing in France before **31st December 2020** must apply by **30 June 2021**.

### Constitutive The versus French declaratory? **System**

France adopted a constitutive system, which meant legislation was required setting out what criteria process UKNs would need to meet and the process to follow. This was published on 19 November 2020.


### In practice

The French government created an online portal through which all UKNs (and their dependants) have to apply. The dossiers are processed by the local prefecture. UKNs are then invited to an appointment to give their biometrics and the residency cards are posted to the UKN.

## Some key questions...

### How many Brits live in France?

148,00 according to Insee 2016 figures but the true number, believed to be larger is unknown - so far around 125,00 UKNs have applied.

### What about Covid?

Covid and the resulting restrictions meant we had to reshape our service to be primarily online, via our website and telephone helpline.

We have a project team including four caseworkers who provide support via email, telephone, virtual zoom sessions and in extreme cases in-person visits.







### Complex cases - we are here to help

Although the online portal application system is relatively straightforward for most, UK national circumstances can be complex. For example:

- integration into the French healthcare, tax and employment structures
- falling between 2 residency categories
- dependants or spouses who are French or third-country nationals
- those with health or other vulnerabilities
- those with online accessibility issues
- UKNs who are just deeply confused by the whole process!



### The challenges...

#### A learning curve

This was a new process with many unknowns...At launch we were still awaiting the French legislation that would set out how the WA would be implemented in practice.

#### **Conflicting information**

Social media and everyone knows best! Many UKNs have been confused by conflicting and often incorrect information given by unofficial sources and online forums.

#### **Reaching people**

Covid, the vulnerable and those offline. One of the biggest challenges has been communicating the residency requirements to all UKNs, especially those who are not online.

#### **Regional variance**

The Prefecture factor. Although the portal is centralised, applications are processed regionally and not all prefectures have applied the legislation as intended.

### Using technology

The French portal system is relatively straightforward and streamlined but for those unfamiliar with technology or without online access it can be challenging..

#### Missed the boat?

We are still awaiting confirmation on what allowances may be made for anyone missing the application deadline 30 June 2021.
